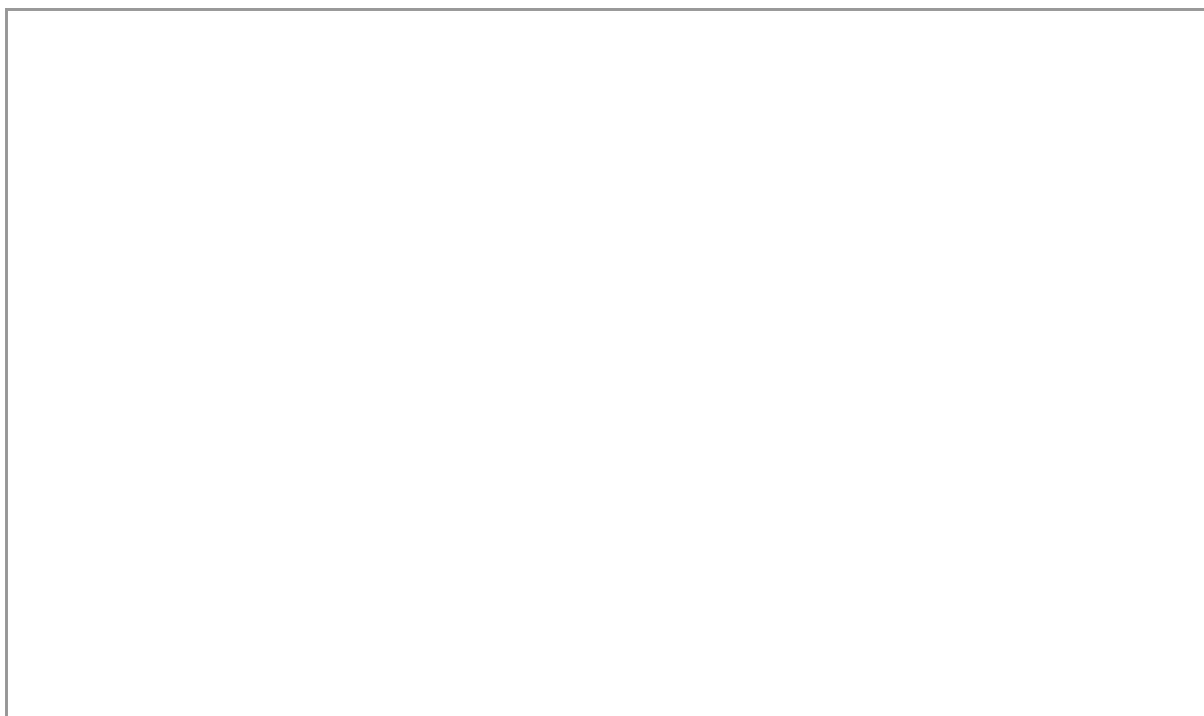

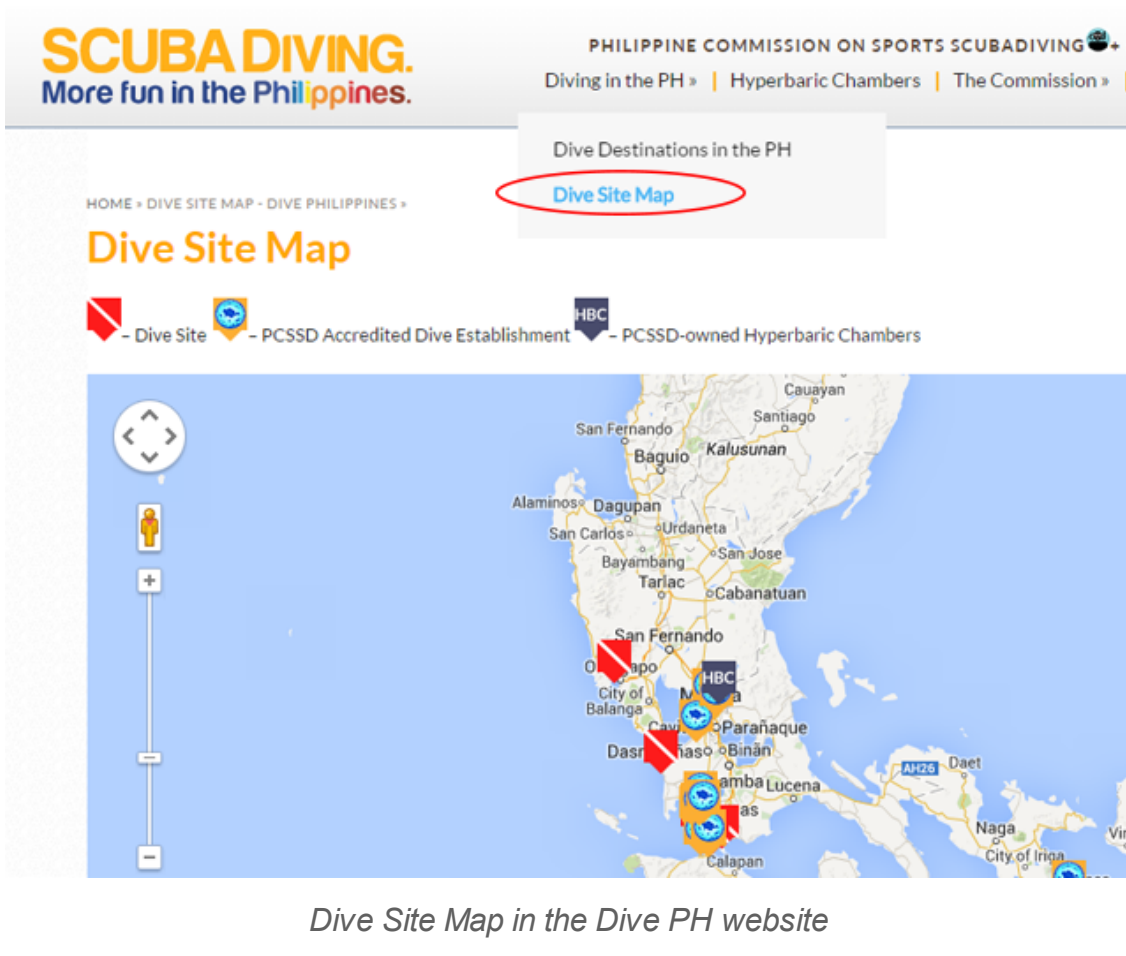
HOME » ANILAO, BATANGAS DIVE SITES - DIVE PHILIPPINES »

Just south of Manila, the province of Batangas has some of the best dive sites off the coast of Luzon. These include Fortune Island, sites near Matabungkay and the most famous Balayan Bay, home to the sleepy little town of Anilao, the birthplace of diving in the Philippines.

<b>CATHEDRAL ROCK/3'S CUEVAS</b>	In Cathedral Rock you will find soft corals, sponges, nudibranchs, and many tropical fish, among them angelfish, butterfly fish, wrasse, surgeonfish and anemones with clownfish. The cross is situated in between two rocks and was brought there by former president Fidel Ramos on 1983.
<b>LIGPO CAVE</b>	It has abig area covered with soft corals and is 10m.-30m. / 33ft.-100ft. in depth.
<b>LIGPO ISLAND</b>	Ligpo Island is a small island located at the province of Lemery Batangas, close to the Costal area of Anilao. It can be traveled around on one dive.
<b>LIGPO PINNACLE</b>	The journey to the Pinnacle is half the fun, best done in even 2 dives to make the most of the shallow walls with colorful bush and fan anemones, the deeper wall with huge fan corals.
<b>DIVE &amp; TREK (CAVERN)</b>	This site was called the bus stop in previous years because large pelagics were known to park in this area. The cavern had a cross on top made out of concrete and a Virgin Mary statue. Inside it features midnight snappers, napoleon fishes and groupers.
<b>ANILAO PIER</b>	The place was originally known as "Janao-Janao" and is said to be derived from the geographical shape and feature of the land and water comprising the barrio.
<b>ANILAO BEACH CLUB HOUSE REEF</b>	The entire island is a nature reserve, and there are two fish protection areas around the island. Diving is most beautiful at the North side, but the other sides are also nice.
<b>MATU POINT</b>	
<b>EAGLE POINT</b>	Eagle Point Beach and Dive Resort is the Leading Scuba Diving, Snorkeling, Leisure & Family Beach Resort and Hotel in Anilao Batangas, Philippines. This seaside haven was developed with adventure and comfort in mind for everyone. A year round destination for underwater scuba divers, open water sports enthusiasts, adventurers, nature lovers and for those who would just like to unwind from the hustle and bustle of the city life.
<b>KOALA</b>	Koala is a very referable diving site for novice divers because of its medium currents and gentle slopes.
<b>ARTIFICIAL ROCK</b>	This site starts out as a gradual slope from around 5M. Then you eventually go down to around 18-20M. Then you will see a small wall with some boulders and a small
